Pastor's Message BY REV. TYSON TAYLOR

The US armed forces use a system to signify the alert status of our armed forces. This system is called DEFCON (defense readiness condition). DEFCON 5 indicates times of peace and lowered precautions. DEFCON 1

would indicate that nuclear war is imminent or already started.

Lakeside has borrowed this language as we made plans for how to defend and respond to Covid-19. For us, DEFCON 1 is the worst-case scenario where we have no live services or live programming. We were in DEFCON 1 for several weeks when the pandemic started. We only streamed services, and we did not have any meetings. Several months later, we decided to move to DEFCON 2, which included masked and socially distanced services where we discouraged singing and checked temperatures at the door. But still, we halted all small groups and programming. Several months after that, we moved to DEFCON 3, which allowed us to have some additional programming with social distancing and masks worn.

I want to let you know that the Session of Lakeside has made plans to move to **DEFCON 4 on March 21st** (although this is a fluid situation, and we continue to monitor infection rates). This move means that we will have two different precaution levels for our two services.

- -The 9 am worship service will continue to require masks & check temperatures for attendance, but singing will be encouraged with masks.
- -The 11 am service will allow for the removal of masks once you're seated and socially distanced. We will not be checking temperatures, and singing will be encouraged. (continued on page 2)

DEFCON 4 also allows for Sunday schools and small groups to meet, with masks being optional, but social distancing still practiced.

- -Therefore, Lakeside Sunday school will begin meeting on March 21st.
- -We will also begin our Wednesday Night meals and programming on March 24th. Meals will look a little different to accommodate social distancing.

We live in a fluid world with news and understanding of the global pandemic. Therefore, our plans may change. Please know that if conditions change, we might need to return to DEFCON 3 and require masks to be worn for our congregation's safety. I know the whole DEFCON thing is kinda silly. But remember who you have as your pastor. I've included our DEFCON chart below for you to see. Please continue to pray for the other elders and me. Our task is not easy, but we remain hopeful that light is just around the corner. Christ is Lord, and God is sovereign. I love and miss you


